IV Conference on FP7 in Spain, 13-14 April 2010

The city of Valencia will be the venue for the "FP7: INNOVATION AND RTD TRANSFORMING SECTORS WEEK", which will hold the Conference as its core event: April 13th will be devoted to "Energy Efficient Building (EeB)" and "Factories of the Future (FoF)", during which INESCOP will participate in Session III Round Table "Way ahead and a look at the Future". Furthermore, April 14th sessions will cover "Green Cars (GC)" and "Future Internet (FI)".
